Key Stage 2 SATs Results 2004

Our Year 6 pupils have again achieved excellent results in the national Standardised Assessment Tests held in May. Level 4 is the standard expected to be achieved by Year 6 pupils; Level 5 is above expectations. The results were as follows (in % of children):

English (overall)	86% achieved Level 4 and above	45% achieved Level 5
Reading	88% achieved Level 4 and above	44% achieved Level 5
Writing	86% achieved Level 4 and above	36% achieved Level 5
Maths	78% achieved Level 4 and above	42% achieved Level 5
Science	95% achieved Level 4 and above	46% achieved Level 5

Congratulations to the pupils and to the members of staff who helped them achieve such outstanding results. Year 6 reports, with individual results and teacher assessment will be forwarded to parents/carers next week.
